- Purpose: To permit active memberships by employees of a government entity in Delaware and to provide that board representation for the Eastern Region can be from Delaware as well as from Maryland Counties on the Eastern Shore.

Article III. Membership

Section 1. Classes of Membership

There are five classes of membership in the Association:

Active

Active membership may be held by any employee of a governmental entity in Maryland **or Delaware** who is employed in government financial management.

Article VI. Board of Directors

Section 2. Composition and Representation

The Board of Directors of the Association shall be composed of 22 Directors having broad representation from both the private and public sectors, including the State and local governments from all Maryland regions as specified in this section **with the exception of Section 2.j. below.**

- One Eastern region representing Caroline, Cecil, Dorchester, Kent, Queen Anne's, Somerset, Talbot, Wicomico, and Worcester Counties; [**and Delaware** and]
- One Western region representing Allegany, Frederick, Garrett, and Washington Counties[.]; **and**
- **Delaware.**
