The [Department of Finance](#) is recruiting for an [Accountant/Auditor](#) as part of their mission to prudently manage financial operations, recommend and implement sound fiscal policies, safeguard public assets, and encourage a safe environment on public property. Employee will perform professional accounting/auditing work. The employee must understand Government Accounting Standards Board (GASB) accounting standards and other requirements related to governmental, enterprise, special revenue, internal service, and fiduciary funds, capital projects, retiree pension payroll, and fixed assets; and the budgeting and accounting procedures for capital projects with grant and/or debt funding sources. Employee must understand federal cost principles. Employee will be expected to be proficient in using ERP accounting systems and other current technology.

Duties may include, but are not limited to:

1. Preparing analyses of statements and reports and making recommendations regarding the analyses
2. Preparing records for the disbursement of funds
3. Preparing financial statements and disclosures for the Single Audit Report and Annual Comprehensive Financial Report

4. Reconciling accounts in preparation of fiscal year-end and grant closings
5. Serving as a financial resource person
6. Preparing and analyzing bank reconciliation statements and preparing expenditure or grant reports
7. Preparing and accounting for retirees' pension payroll along with the associated Maryland State Tax withholding and IRS reporting

A criminal background and credit history check will be conducted on the selected candidate prior to appointment and will be a significant factor in the hiring decision.
