

Insurance Risk Analyst Montgomery County Government Department of Finance, Division of Risk Management Rockville, MD

Minimum Salary: \$70,119

The Montgomery County Self-Insurance Program, established under County Code 20-37, and administered by the <u>Department of Finance</u>, provides comprehensive property and casualty insurance for the County and participating member agencies. The program provides accurate and timely insurance and risk management advice to County departments and participating agencies and reduces County and participating agency exposure to risk by comparing the cost of commercially available coverage to evaluate the best method of funding exposure to loss; transferring contractual risk under indemnification/hold harmless agreements; avoiding risk; and purchasing commercial insurance policies.

The Department of Finance is seeking a candidate for the <u>Insurance Risk Analyst</u> position in the Department of Finance, Division of Risk Management, reporting to the Insurance Manager. This position is responsible for reviewing County contracts and other types of agreements including, but not limited to, leases, easements, Memorandum of Understanding, and Right of Entry agreements, for transfer of risk and the development of indemnification provisions.

The position requires:

- Thorough knowledge of commercial insurance coverages and limits, bonds, and other similar instruments.
- Ability to analyze Certificates of Insurance for contract required insurance and indemnification compliance (non-insurance transfer).
- Ability to analyze contractual scope of work to determine potential risks to determine insurance and similar financial instruments to limit County risk.
- Ability to manage high volume, concurrent projects, and deadlines.
- Ability to interpret analyses, financial statements, laws, regulations, policies, and procedures associated with risk management and avoidance.
- Ability to develop and make improvements in procedures, forms, and records.
- Interpersonal skills to establish and maintain effective working relationships with County staff, County managers at all levels, and contractual staff.
- Ability to communicate and negotiate proficiently orally and in writing to multiple audiences and organizations.
- A strong customer-service focus is key, as the position has significant interaction with both inside and outside colleagues and
 acts as a subject matter expert related to contractual risk transference and indemnification for the County. Position may be
 telework eligible after training is complete.

A criminal background and credit history check will be conducted on the selected candidate prior to appointment and will be a significant factor in the hiring decision.
